

# Poh Choy wins A Medal on countback

FOUR participants returned with identical score in the A Medal of the Cleveland Srixon CSSB Open golf championships at the Staffield Country Resort in Mantin, Negri Sembilan recently.

The four - Ng Poh Choy, Mohd Narik Hanafiah, Ho Chwee Hoon and Azuril Adnan - each garnered 40 points. But among the four Poh Choy, who plays to a 12-handicap, was the lucky one and was declared the champion on countback.

As the champion, Poh Choy won a four-day/three-night golf package to the grand finals in Korat and Ayutthaya.

Mohd Narik was the runner-up while Chwee Hoon settled for the third spot.

In the Gross category, Mohd Zaid Mohd Noor, a 13-handicapper, shot a three-over 75 to win the title by two strokes over Lee Pak Hong who signed off with a 77. Both Mohd Zaid and Lee will join Poh Choy in the grand finals in Thailand.

There was a close battle in the B Medal. Mohd Rodzi Sulaiman, who plays to 23 handicap, collected 46 points to win the title by one point over Zamri Mohd. In third place was Sharin Tahir on 42 points.
