- 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1) is indicated by white stakes and/or lines Where both stakes and lines exist, the line defines the out of bounds.
- 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26-1) are indicated by yellow stakes and/or lines on Hole 3, 4, 6 and I extend to the boundary of the course Lateral water hazards are indicated by red stakes and/or fines. The hazards
